Particular of grounds for Re-allocation

- 1. A judgment dated 20th July 2011 was set aside by Deputy District Judge Sinner sitting at Example County Court.
- Upon putting the Default Judgment aside, Judge Sinner restored the claim under Part 13.6 of The Rules and Practice Direction. On which occasion Judge Sinner also requested the claim for damages and anxiety to be specified.

- 5. In causing distress and anxiety from delays and inconveniences, the Defendant prevents the Claimant from being able to do his job, thus contravenes the **International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights Article 1(2).**
